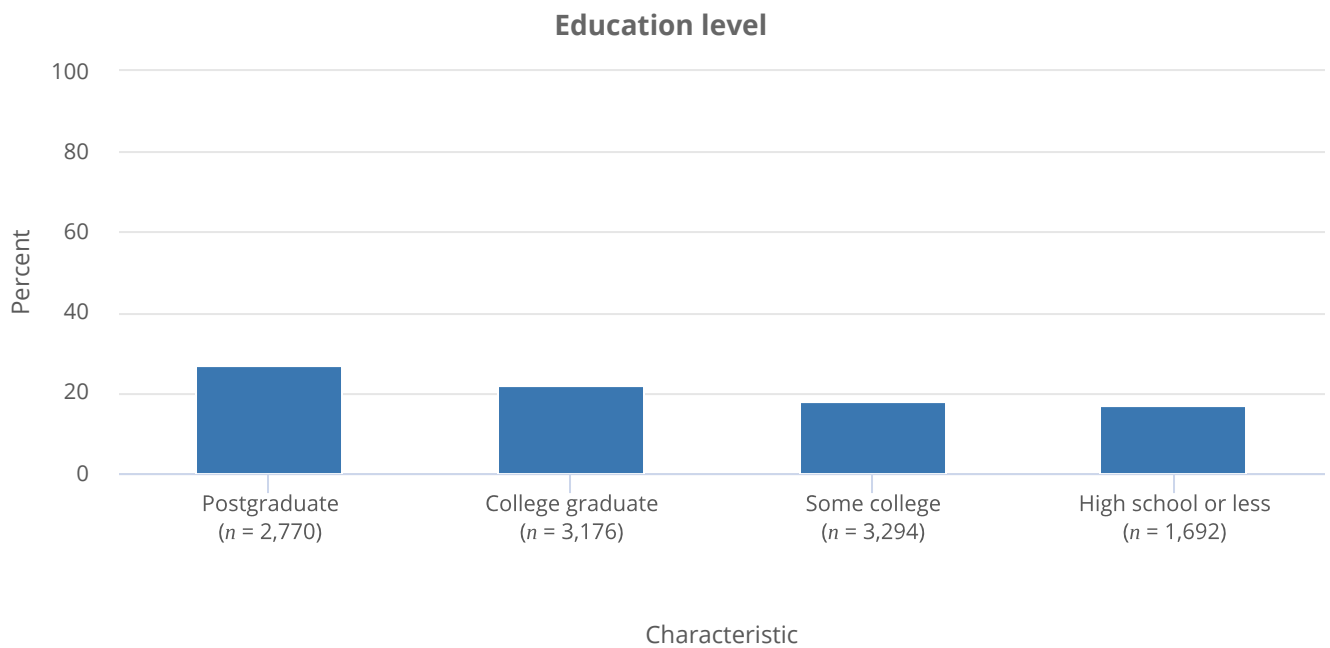
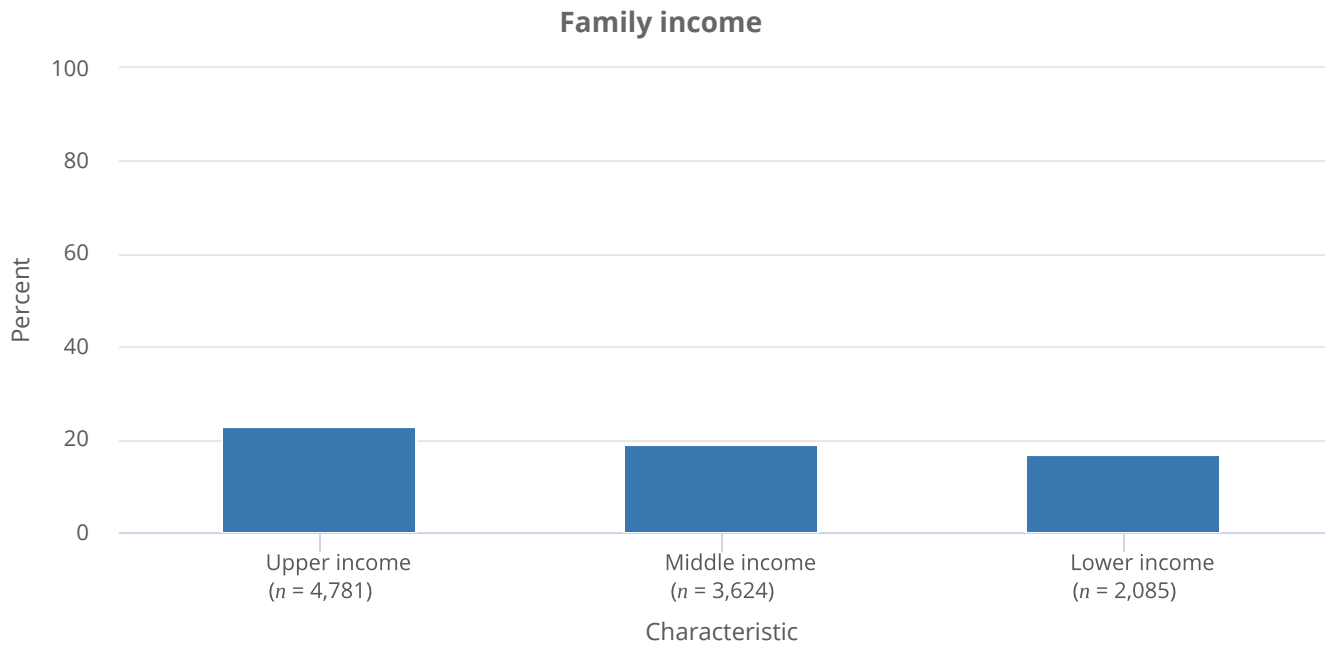

For a three-person household, upper income is approximately \$112,601 and above, middle income is from \$37,500 to \$112,600, and lower income is less than \$37,500.
